Start Order (both days):

Ptarmigan: U12, U10, U8 girls, followed by U12, U10, U8 boys

North Wall: U14, U16, U18, U20 girls, followed by U14, U16, U18, and U20 boys

Lift Tickets:

All race tickets available only through this link and MUST be purchased by Friday, February 21, at 9 pm: [WIJARA Racer Ticket Link](#)

- Racer Single-Day Ticket: \$89 +tax for Juniors (0-17) and \$99 +tax for Adults (18+)
- Racer Two-Day Racer Ticket: \$158 +tax (valid open to close 3/1/2025 – 3/2/2025)
- Parent/Non-Racer Single Day Ticket: \$89 +tax for Juniors (0-17) and \$99 +tax for Adults (18+)
- 12 and under tickets not valid for race event
- No form of discounted ticket (other than Racer ticket), voucher ticket, or coupon ticket valid for race event
- Must have a Racer ticket to race in the event
- Must have a valid ticket somewhere on your person to load any lift at any time
- Online racer lift tickets will be available for pickup beginning Friday, February 28, at 5 pm through race weekend, during normal online ticket pickup building hours

Online ticket purchase refunds are as follows:

- Refunds requested 7 days prior to ticket date will be refunded back to the form of payment used.
- Refunds requested 6 days to 1 day prior to ticket date will be refunded to a Cascade Mountain gift card.

Daily Morning Schedule:

- 6:30 Main Parking lot opens
- 7:00 Daisy Lodge parking lot opens
- 7:00 – 7:15 Mountain Top Express chair lift opens to Cascade coaches and course setting crew
- 7:00 lift ticket window opens –
 - For online ticket purchase use QR code from online ticket purchase at online ticket pickup building
 - For season pass holders use lift ticket window in lower Peak Lodge
- 7:30 Mountain Top Express chair lift opens to officials (jury members MUST have an armband)
- 7:35 Mountain Top Express chair lift opens to racers
- 7:40 – 7:55 course inspection by officials/jury
- 8:00 Gatekeepers meeting at Rob's Roost (base of Ptarmigan)
- 8:00 – 8:10 Cascade inspection
- 8:10 – 8:20 Chestnut/Blackhawk inspection
- 8:20 – 8:30 Wilmot inspection
- 8:30 – 8:40 Tyrol/Hidden Valley/Snowstar inspection
- 8:40 – 8:50 Four Lakes/Sundown inspection
- 8:50 inspection closed AND forerunners and gatekeepers in place
- **9:00 Race 1 starts**

****Senior Runs will be at the conclusion of the slalom race on Sunday on North Wall****
Nothing may be left on the snow following the Senior Run

Notes:

- Course inspection: Classes U8 and U10 may slip the course if required. All others must inspect from outside the course. Specific inspection guidelines will be communicated the day of the race based on conditions.
- Gatekeepers meeting will be held on BOTH mornings at 8 am in Rob's Roost. Gatekeepers should be on course by 8:50 am (walk up from bottom or ski down from top to marked gatekeeper location).
- Giant Slalom (GS) Race 1 will consist of two runs. Racer's times are combined. GS Race 2 in the afternoon is a single run race. Both slalom races are one run each.
- DQ and DNF bib numbers will be posted on scoreboards at the bottom of each hill 15 minutes after each race. Contact **your coach** if you receive a DQ. Your coach will discuss the infraction with the Jury (Referee, TD and/or Chief of Race). Coaches will have 15 minutes after posting to file a protest with the Jury. Scoring and timing corrections are allowed up until 5 pm Monday following racing.
- Award Ceremony will occur at the conclusion of the race day at the Daisy Lodge.
 - Upon request, and at the conclusion of the last race each day, a shuttle vehicle will be available from the lower parking lot to the Daisy to help transport those not on skis to the Daisy for awards.
 - Shuttle will transport back to lower parking lot upon completion of awards presentations.

WIJARA Race Venue:

- Cascade Mountain lodges are also open to the public all weekend. Bags can be stored in Rob's Roost and the lower Daisy Lodge. Unattended bags (including coolers) in all other areas will be removed. These items should be kept in race team members' vehicles.
- Skis should be placed in ski racks or the Free Ski Corral at the base. Do not leave skis laying on snow – they will be moved.
- Plug-in cooking appliances of any kind are not allowed in any lodges or buildings (this includes Nesco's, microwaves, crock pots, hot plates, coffee makers, etc.).
- There is not outside food or beverage allowed in the Coffee Shop or bar areas.
- **Carry in alcohol is prohibited.**
- Cascade Ski Team will have two race headquarters tables: one near Peak Lodge at the base of the hill and one at in the lower level of Daisy Lodge for those at the top of the hill. Please go to these information tables with any race weekend questions once at Cascade. Volunteers will be available from 7 am until completion of races

to answer questions.

- Tailgating rules:
 - Empty parking spaces cannot be used to tailgate
 - No open flames
 - Propane tanks are limited to 2 lb tanks or smaller
 - Carry in alcohol is prohibited
- Tech Shop (Service and Repair Center):
 - Equipment needed for Saturday's race (GS Skis) must be dropped off by 6 pm on Friday for guaranteed pick up at 8 am on Saturday.
 - Equipment needed for Sunday's race (Slalom Skis) must be dropped off by 6 pm on Saturday for guaranteed pick up at 8 am on Sunday.
 - We will not begin work on equipment needed for Sunday's race until Saturday morning.

Coaches and Gatekeepers Passes

- Teams will receive one coach ticket per 10 racers, with a max of five coach tickets per team. Please email Susan Allen (susan@cascaDEMOUNTAINskiteam.org) with the names of coaches receiving lift tickets.
- Coaches must sign the Cascade Mountain waiver ([Cascade Race Waiver](#)) and the WIJARA Code of Conduct ([WIJARA Coaches CoC](#)).
- Coaches' packets will be available at Daisy Lodge race headquarters.
- Gatekeeper lift tickets will be available *for gatekeepers who signed up via Sign-Up Genius*. Gatekeepers' lift tickets will be available at Gatekeepers meeting in Rob's Roost. ONLY gatekeepers who are on the Sign-Up Genius list will receive a gatekeeper lift ticket and must sign the Cascade Mountain waiver ([Cascade Race Waiver](#))
 - ***Gatekeepers INCLUDE THEIR TEAM NAME, email, and phone number in the "comment" section of Sign Up Genius.***
- **Officials:** (TD, Chief of Race, Referee, Assistant Referee) *from visiting teams* will also receive a comp lift ticket that will be with coaches' packets at Peak Lodge race headquarters
- **Coaches:** WIJARA radios and officials' bands will be available at the lower level of Daisy Lodge race headquarters
 - Officials' bands will not work for lift access. Lift tickets must be worn.
